Purpose of the Project

This project is a project whereby the individual or institutional donors indicate or instruct the MIF to use their donations ONLY for the specific area or group of poor or vulnerable distressed people. The MIF define this type of donations as Targeted Donations. Thus, the SVDP Transparency project is targeted to the poor and/or vulnerable distressed people in different parts of Myanmar who are severely distressed as they lost their jobs as professionals and trained technicians in auditing, accounting and transparency-related areas unlawfully dismissed by the military and are facing dire difficulties with families, including women and children.

Use of funds

The MIF may not use donations or funds received for this project for other areas or projects. Therefore, they are treated as funds received acting as an agent as defined in the IRS Instructions i990 page 77, Gross Receipts explanations.

Financial Reporting

In the MIF accounting system, such targeted donations are reported as accounts payable until the project is implemented and related expenditures are reported back and set off from the accounts payable account. Any outstanding balance not yet implemented will be outstanding as accounts payable. No administrative or overhead fee is charged on this project. The related reports will be made available publicly through adopted reporting channels and methods.
